This major retrospective of British artist Donald Rodney brings together nearly all that survives of his work across painting, drawing, installation, sculpture, and digital media. The exhibition highlights Rodney's significance in British art, addressing themes of racial identity, Black masculinity, and Britain's colonial past.

Magdalena Suarez Frimkess: The Finest Disregard

This first major museum exhibition of Venezuelan-born artist Magdalena Suarez Frimkess features ceramics, paintings, and drawings from over five decades, including collaborative works with her husband, Michael Frimkess.



I Have Been to Hell and Back. And Let Me Tell You, It Was Wonderful

Mori Art Museum | Minato, Japan

The exhibition is Louise Bourgeois's largest solo show in Japan in 27 years, featuring over 100 works. The subtitle, taken from a late fabric work, reflects Bourgeois's resilience and dark humor in confronting themes of suffering, memory, and the human condition.



Arte Povera

Through January 20, 2025

Bourse de Commerce-Pinault Collection | Paris, France

The exhibition showcases over 250 works, featuring the thirteen key artists of the Italian movement and contemporary pieces influenced by it. Curated by Carolyn Christov-Bakargiev, the exhibition explores Arte Povera's legacy, with works from prestigious collections and artists whose practices engage with its heritage.





Zanele Muholi

Through January 26, 2025

The Metropolitan Museum of Art | New York, NY

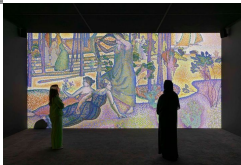
The exhibition is showcasing over 300 photographs from Muholi, documenting and celebrating the lives of South Africa's Black LGBTQIA+ communities. The exhibition includes key series such as "Only Half the Picture," "Faces and Phases," and "Being," as well as the dramatic self-portraits of "Somnyama Ngonyama."

Post-Impressionism: Beyond Appearances

The exhibition features iconic works by Post-Impressionist masters like Van Gogh, Cézanne, and Redon, organized into nine sections that explore their individual styles and shared themes.



Tacita Dean: Blind Folly

Through February 29, 2025

The Menil Collection | Houston, TX

The exhibition highlights Dean's chance-based art-making process across various mediums, including film and printmaking. Featuring new works inspired by her time in Houston and her residency at the Cy Twombly Gallery, the exhibition also includes monumental blackboard drawings and rare studio drawings.

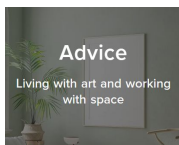
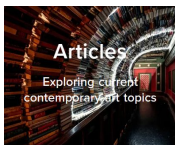
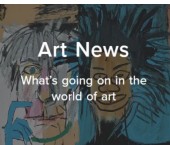
Northern Lights

January 26 - May 25, 2025

The exhibition will feature around 80 landscape paintings by Scandinavian and Canadian artists from 1880 to 1930, including works by Hilma af Klint and Edvard Munch, inspired by the boreal forest. This first-of-its-kind European exhibition traces the development of Nordic landscape painting, highlighting both renowned and lesser-known artists.
